DISTRICT ATTORNEY DECLINES TO SEEK DEATH PENALTY AGAINST DAVID ANTHONY GREEN AFTER PRELIMINARY HEARING

Los Angeles, January 14, 2009:

After the preliminary hearing was conducted in the case, The Special Circumstances Committee of The Los Angeles District Attorney's Office announced today that it would not be seeking the death penalty against David Anthony Green for an alleged gang-related double homicide. The DA's Office also voluntarily dismissed the gang allegation, immediately after the preliminary hearing.

"The District Attorney's decision today, while laudable, reflects what we have been asserting all along – this is not a case that remotely warrants killing my client," said Anthony N. Luti of The Luti Law Firm, which represents Mr. Green. "The battle is far from over. As we said before today's developments, Mr. Green looks forward to telling a jury his story in court."
